

Extracts from official rules & regulations

Please try to arrive between 9 am to 9 pm, arriving families are received non-stop.

The price per day is reckoned until 10:00 the next morning ; every time spent after 10 a.m. is counted as another complete day and charged accordingly.

Payment must be made during office opening times the day before you leave (8:45 to 12:00 and 16:30 to 19:30).

Campers with visitors must inform reception and pay for their stay. Visitor tax is 4 € per person and 1 € per car.

Camping "Cévennes Provence" is a relaxed and a family-friendly camp site.

We ask our clientele to respect the rules for the benefit of all.

At 10:30

- All camp activities stop.
- Bar closure.
- The lights are turned off.
- Silence is compulsory in the whole camp site, in the playground and near the river
- Radios and music are forbidden.
- Drive slowly and quietly.



During the day :

- Radios and music are allowed quietly.
- Be careful when driving in the camp site : no speeding, no horns, no unnecessary engine noise.



As a result of a departmental bye-law all wood-fires are forbidden.

Gas and electric barbecues are tolerated at individual camping pitches as long as practical precautions are taken (a cleared area and a bucket of water on hand).



Charcoal barbecues are tolerated **only on the communal (brick) barbecue sites.**

Do not let children play in the sanitary facilities or near the water taps.

Respect nature in the camp site as well as in its surroundings.

Away from the washing lines provided, washing should be hung up as discreetly as possible in the sites.

When you leave, clean up your camping place and please don't leave any stones : the mower does not appreciate them !



Cats and dogs must be vaccinated for rabies (vaccination certificate compulsory).

Dogs must be kept on a lead.

There are two rivers near the camping site. Dogs are allowed to swim only in one river. A dog path has been made.

"Poop-scoops" are distributed freely at reception.



Children and teenagers are the responsibility of their parents.

Young people can meet in the evening in the premises provided, on the Saint Jean du Gard Gardon river bank.

No camp fires. Don't break glass bottles.

Bring back bottles and rubbish.

Return to the camping place must be silent. No congregating at the sanitary blocks.



As well as the penalties provided for by the law, byelaws and decrees, any breach of the rules will lead to the **expulsion of the perpetrators from the camp site.**
