Camping Cévennes Provence is proud to hold the « Qualité Sud de France » label.

Our campsite lies on the edge of the « Parc National des Cévennes », which is listed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site.

We also lie in the « Natura 2000 » territory.



DUSTBINS: There is one main waste collection point on the campsite, in the stone shelter near the entrance. Here you can deposit general waste, used batteries and dry bread for animals.

In front of the stone shelter is the recycling area:

- Green bin: glass
- Yellow bin: plastic bottles, cartons, cans and tins
- Blue bin: newspapers, magazines and catalogues, etc.

There are small bins throughout the campsite for small amounts of waste.

- Bakery: Every morning fresh bread, croissants, pains au chocolat and brioches...

For tents, caravans and campers, take 25 meters of cable with blue EURO plug. To rent a refrigerator on your site, bring your own cable as well.



BAR & ROTISSERIE



Open from April 07 to
September 16, 2018

You can enjoy soft and alcoholic drinks, ice-creams and milk shakes on one of our wonderful terraces, outside or covered. Try our home-made pizzas, various meat and chicken dishes, mixed salads, French fries, pancakes and desserts. There is also a daily set menu and a children's menu.

OTHER SERVICES (depending on season)

Price and program of activities at the reception:

- Relaxing and equilibrating massages with or without essential oils for your well-being, on a massage table
- Pottery lessons, archery, Hatha yoga, pony rides, sports activities, Laser Game
- Since 2016 on Monday mornings, hairdressing salon with Coralie. Make your appointment at reception.

In 2017, 2016, 2014, 2012, 2008: 5 totally renovated sanitary buildings.

There are baby baths in sanitary block n°3, n°6 and n°9.

Shower room with 2 showers; for parent and child.

New Launderette in 2016: 3 washing machines, 1 tumble drier (tokens sold at the shop), two laundry tub sinks with hot water

Dogs: free distribution of "poop-scoops".
A dog shower nearby sanitary block n°3.

Camping cars: a free service area is provided for the disposal of waste water and filling up with fresh water.

Wheelchair access to the sanitary equipment, river, shop, bar and restaurant, wi-fi terrace, launderette and hairdresser's...

NATURE

- It is possible to go on walks within the camp site:



- Visit to the Xth century tower
- Sentier de la source
- View from the Puech
- Chemin des arbousiers...

- A lot of walks starting from the camp site and from Anduze (walking guides 5€ and maps sold at reception).

- There are more than 120 species of trees and bushes on the camping site; a list is available at reception.

- Help yourself to herbs at the mini-golf free: please use scissors and only take what you need.

- Bathing in calm water above the dam, or more adventurously, among the rocks of the Gardon gorge.



- Fishing: licences (compulsory from the age of 7) on sale from reception (annual permits, 7-day holiday licences or daily licence).

LEISURE / AMUSEMENTS

- An adventure and discovery park on the border of the camping-site with children and adults course. Reservations and discounts when you reserve at camping reception.

- 15 000 m² near the river: football, volley ball, basketball, badminton, 2 slacklines, 5 picnic tables...

- A large playground for children from the age of 2. 3 ping-pong tables.

- Games room with table football, video games...



- Tennis court and 18-hole mini-golf course: free in April, May, June and September. In July and August tennis court cost 3 € per hour and mini-golf 2 € per adult and 1 € per kid.

- Pétanque (bowling) court lit until 22:30 with seasonal organized tournaments.

- July and August: few live music shows from 9.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.



RESERVATIONS

Reservations are possible starting from the beginning of January according to availability.

There are 226 empty pitches for tents, caravans or motor-homes.

No pitch available for year rental.

You can rent a fridge for your individual camping place.

16 chalets for 2 to 6 persons for rental: We advise you to book in time!

LOW SEASON HOLIDAYS

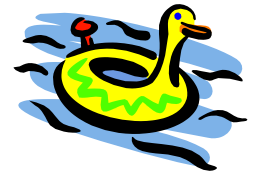


The camp site is open from March 20th until October 1st. Due to the Mediterranean climate, the region is pleasant from the first days of Spring.

Reductions for tents and caravans and on chalet prices during low season.

This administration fee for a pitch is offered for a stay starting from 20th March to 30th June and from 22nd August to 1st October.

For your comfort, one of our toilet and shower blocks is heated in spring and autumn.



We are happy to give you any information:

Doctors' addresses, garages, festivals, concerts, visits to tourist sites, and any kind of leisure activities. Canoe-kayak, horse and pony riding, adventure sports, speleology, first flight in the helicopter, canyoning: discounts when you reserve at reception.

You can find brochures and posters for tourist visits on the bar terrace. Entertainments are advertised on the notice board. You can get some discounts at reception.

Local markets (on mornings): Mondays in Lasalle (13 km), Tuesdays in St Jean du Gard (10 Km), Thursdays in Anduze (4 km) ...

Nocturnal markets in July and August:

Tuesdays in Anduze and Thursdays in St Jean du Gard.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

You can call us in case of emergency at number 00 33 4 66 61 73 10 (24 hours a day).

We sleep on the camping site.

There is a defibrillator at the reception.

In case of fire there are 4 evacuation assembly points: pétanque, in front of waste collecting point, area near the river and under sanitary block n° 9.

Should there be a thunder storm, wait until the rain stops; the water will run off rapidly. It is forbidden to dig trenches round the camping places.

In order to protect the grass, it is recommended that you do not use vinyl ground sheets.

The canal on the other side of the river and the dam are private, it is forbidden and dangerous to walk on. The beach "Parc Parfum d'Aventure" is reserved for their customers.

Extracts from official rules & regulations

Please try to arrive between 9 am to 9 pm, arriving families are received non-stop.

The price per day is reckoned until 10:00 the next morning; every time spent after 10 a.m. is counted as another complete day and charged accordingly.

Payment must be made during office opening times the day before you leave (8:30 to 12:00 and 16:30 to 19:30).

Campers with visitors must inform reception and pay for their stay. Visitor tax is 4 € per person and 1 € per car.

**Camping "Cévennes Provence" is a relaxed and a family-friendly camp site.
We ask our clientele to respect the rules for the benefit of all.**

During the day:



- ❑ Radios and music are allowed quietly.
- ❑ Be careful when driving in the camp site: no speeding, no horns, no unnecessary engine noise.

At 10:30:

- ❑ All camp activities stop.
- ❑ Bar closure.
- ❑ The lights are turned off.
- ❑ Silence is compulsory in the whole camp site, in the playground and near the river
- ❑ Radios and music are forbidden.
- ❑ Drive slowly and quietly.



As a result of a departmental by-law all wood-fires are forbidden.

Gas and electric barbecues are tolerated at individual camping pitches as long as practical precautions are taken (a cleared area and a bucket of water on hand).

Charcoal barbecues are tolerated **only on the communal (brick) barbecue sites.**



Do not let children play in the sanitary block or near the water taps.

Respect nature in the camp site as well as in its surroundings.

Away from the washing lines provided, washing should be hung up as discreetly as possible in the sites.

When you leave, clean up your camping place and please don't leave any stones: the mower does not appreciate them!

Dogs must be kept on a lead.

There are two rivers near the camping site. Dogs are allowed to swim only in one river.

"Poop-scoops" are distributed freely at reception.



Children and teenagers are the responsibility of their parents.



Young people can meet in the evening in the premises provided, on the Saint Jean du Gard Gardon river bank.

No camp fires. Don't break glass bottles. Bring back bottles and rubbish.

Return to the camping place must be silent. No congregating at the sanitary blocks.

As well as the penalties provided for by the law, byelaws and decrees, any breach of the rules will lead to the **expulsion of the perpetrators from the camp site.**
